Mayor Gentry called the meeting to order

Resolution 2011-004


Resolution 2011-004 was presented to council for approval. Mayor Gentry commented that the resolution allows for the hiring of a police officer to fill a vacant position. Council previously enacted a freeze on all hiring for the Town of Iva on January 21, 2011. Since that meeting, an officer resigned from the police department. In order for the position to be filled, Council must give approval to the Mayor to fill the vacancy. Ms. Forrester commented that she was concerned that the Mayor may need to bring in casual labor from time to time and the current freeze would not allow to him to that. She commented that council would have to meet to give the Mayor

approval to hire part-time, seasonal and casual labor. Mayor Gentry commented that the freeze could be discussed in more detail at the February 13, 2011 regular council meeting. Mr. Hart made the motion to approve the resolution. Mr. Norwood seconded the motion. All were in favor. The vote was 4-0.
