**Call to Order:**

Mayor Gentry called the meeting to order.

**Invocation and Pledge of Allegiance:**

**Approval of Minutes:**

Mayor Gentry reported that there have been some delays in obtaining an encroachment permit from the South Carolina Department of Transportation to begin the installation of the Hwy 81 Medians. Mayor Gentry reported that he has asked Senator O'Dell and Representative Gambrell for their assistance.

Mr. Norwood commented about the lighting of the Welcome to Iva sign at the north entrance. Mayor Gentry commented that lighting will be changed back to its original illumination soon.
